***Award terms have been revised to include demonstrated financial need as criteria of the award.***

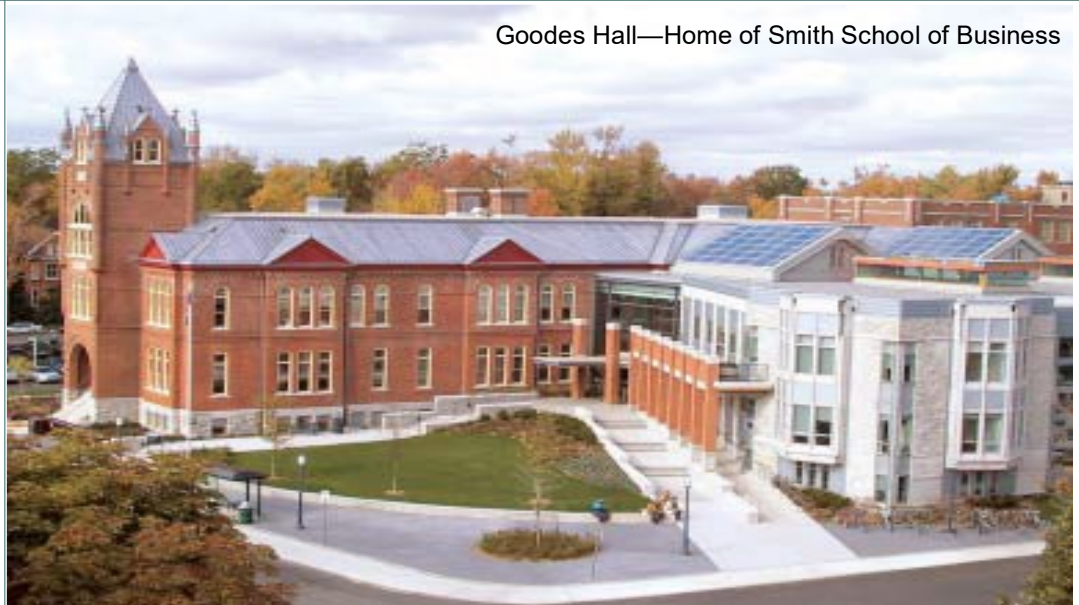
**Value:** Up to 7 awards valued at \$80,000 (\$20,000 x 4 years).

The terms of the award have been revised for the 2019-20 academic year to further promote financial accessibility to those students who may not otherwise have considered Queen's University for their post-secondary studies.

Applicants who are residents of the Atlantic provinces entering the first year of the undergraduate Commerce Program at Queen's University and meet the following criteria may apply:

- Demonstrated academic excellence.
- **Demonstrated financial need.**
- Proven leadership and involvement in school or community activities.
- Must be entering first year Queen's undergraduate Commerce.
- Must be a resident and student of one of the Atlantic provinces.
