## Eligibility Criteria

- Be in your final year of uninterrupted full-time studies in high school
- Have a minimum cumulative average of 85%
- Hold Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status

## Instructions – Application attached

- ✓ Complete pages 1, 2, and 3 in full
- ✓ On pages 4 and 5 - instead of writing the four short essays, summarize these essays in two-three sentences each (do not go over this limit)
- ✓ Indicate who will write your “Letter of Endorsement” on page 6, please ask this person for this permission!

If you wish to be considered, please return the complete application to Mrs. Gallant-Nowlan by **Tuesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> by 9:00 am**

The in-school scholarship committee will review applications and make the final choice; you will be informed within the following week.

- If you are selected as one of three ***school sponsored candidates***, you agree to complete the application in full and submit it by 8pm on October 17<sup>th</sup>.
- If you are not selected as a school sponsored candidate, you can submit your application as a ***Direct Pool Applicant***, due by 8pm on October 24<sup>th</sup>.

This is a very prestigious award and completing the application requires dedication, time and effort. In fact, those who complete the LORAN application are much better prepared for future scholarship applications.
