June 10, 2021 - Graduation Gowns
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graduation gowns will be available for pick up beginning on June 10th during their assigned Track school day. Graduates who have paid their Grad Fee and have no outstanding fees will be able to get their gown. • The Graduation Fee this year is \$70.00. This fee includes the Gown, Cap, Stole, Honour Cords, Tassel, Diploma Cover, Diploma, Media, Decorations, and more. We are implementing a new process that allows all graduates to keep ALL their memento items to continue their celebrations. Nothing will need to be returned. <p>The gowns will arrive packaged and may have creases or wrinkles. There are a few options to remove the wrinkles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put in the dryer with a wet towel. • Steam the material based on the fabric tag. • Hang near a hot shower.

June 22, 2021 at 6:00pm – Virtual Annual Award Ceremony

June 22, 2021 at 7:00pm – Virtual Annual Graduation Ceremony
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Virtual Graduation Ceremony allow the school to celebrate the graduate accomplishments with the Academic Awards and Celebrations. This will be a short video of less than 45 minutes.

June 23 & 24, 2021– Individual Presentation of Diplomas

- We hope you will walk the stage at your graduation as it is an important celebration of your achievement, and a day we wish to make memorable for you. It is important that each family respects the given time and is punctual.
- Guidelines for High School Graduation Ceremonies, Province of New Brunswick May 10, 2021.
*“Schools may need to hold multiple ceremonies to accommodate a larger graduating class. It is recommended that the number of guests per student be limited to **two (2)** to limit the possibility of transmission and to accommodate a larger number of graduates.”*
- **You must wear/bring your complete grad attire to graduation – GOWN, WHITE STOLE, CAP, TASSEL, DIPLOMA COVER.**
- You will receive your paper diploma and honour cord at graduation (if this applies to you).
- If you are thinking of decorating your cap, please do so only after you have walked the stage.
- If you miss your scheduled time, due to PUBLIC HEALTH CONTACT TRACING you cannot show up a different time. You **MUST** call the main office at 856-3439 to reschedule. The only two days available for graduation will be the 23rd and 24th.
- There will be a professional photographer taking pictures when you receive your diploma. In turn there will be opportunities to access the picture and purchase one.
- If you are not attending graduation and you wish to have your diploma mailed to you, please see the main office to make arrangements. All fees must be settled before the office will mail the diploma.

Diploma Process – June 23rd and 24th

- A. Grads must arrive no more than 10 mins before their scheduled time as a family group. The number of guests may change based on Public Health Recommendations. That is out of our control.
- B. Please arrive at the school dressed in your graduation attire and report to the Front Entrance (where buses drop off students) at the assigned time.
- C. Enter the building only when directed by a staff member.
- D. Complete the Public Health COVID Checklist for everyone in your party in the main lobby (The form will be provided).
- E. Please follow the directions of the staff members.
- F. When your name is announced the graduate will walk up the steps to the stage and receive your diploma.
- G. When you walk off the stage, you and your family must exit immediately following arrows and instructions.

Outstanding Fees, Unreturned textbooks, Diploma, Yearbook and Report Card

- Students will receive detailed information regarding outstanding fees or unreturned textbooks which you should return on the same day that you pick-up your graduation attire. **This is necessary to release your diploma, yearbook, and report card to you.**
